

Expression of Interest (EOI)

Tasmanian Badminton Association Inc. (TBA) – new Board

TBA have approved a new constitution with the following objectives:- (a) recognise BA as the BWF recognised national federation for Badminton in Australia and to act as a member of the BA in accordance with the Statutes and Regulations and the BA constitution, (b) conduct, encourage, promote, advance and administer all levels of Badminton in Tasmania inter-dependently with Members and others, except for local pennants and competitions organised by Members, (c) conduct elite State level competitions for both males and females and at junior and senior levels, (d) adopt, formulate, issue, interpret and amend by-laws, rules and regulations for the control and conduct of Badminton in Tasmania in keeping with the terms of the constitution and the BA constitution, as amended from time-to-time, (e) encourage the provision and development of appropriate facilities for participation in Badminton, (f) maintain and enhance standards, quality and reputation of Badminton for the collective and mutual benefit and interests of Members and Badminton, (g) promote the sport of Badminton for commercial, government and public recognition and benefits, (h) select, prepare and enter Tasmanian teams in National competitions, (i) promote, control, manage and conduct state Badminton events, leagues, competitions and championships, (j) undertake other actions or activities necessary, incidental or conducive to advance these objects, (k) have regard to the public interest in its operations, and (l) encourage and promote widespread participation in the sport to enhance opportunities for every participant to reach levels appropriate to their ability and aspiration.

Once the new constitution has been adopted the composition of the Board will be:- (a) Two Elected Directors all of whom will be elected under Rule 14.3, (b) Three Representative Directors, one representative elected by each of the three Constituent Association Members (i.e. STBA, NTBA and NWBA), who shall each retire after the first year after election.

In subsequent years, in accordance with Rule 14.4(c) the Board will consist of:- (a) five Elected Directors all of whom will be elected under Rule 14.3, and (b) up to two additional Appointed Directors who shall be appointed in accordance with Rule 15.

A copy of the Constitution is available upon request.

TBA is therefore seeking expressions of interest from interested & suitably skilled individuals. The positions will be voluntary for a maximum term of 3 years. Interested applicants are asked to provide a brief statement that outlines their knowledge, skills & experience that demonstrates their suitability for this role, a copy of their current Curriculum Vitae and their contact details.

The STBA Management Committee shall elect the STBA representative from submitted EOIs.
