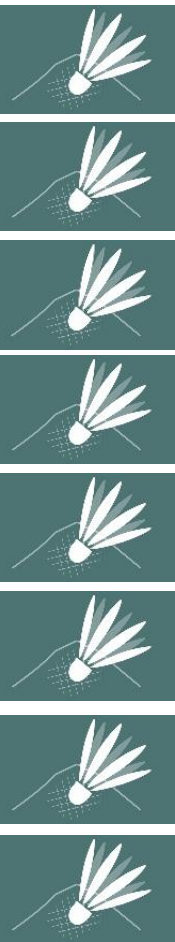
Welcome to Southern Tasmanian Badminton Association's Newsletter.

## Short Format Doubles Roster

There is a short format double roster running for five weeks beginning on the 17<sup>th</sup> of March. The competition is open to all players of any grade and gender and will run on Sunday nights from 7pm to 9pm with a guaranteed 3 doubles matches each night. Players have entered as individuals and the competition will be run in a box format with 4 players per box. Each week the 1<sup>st</sup> place getter in each box will be promoted while the 4<sup>th</sup> place getter moves down a box, effectively making the competition self-grading over 5 weeks. Week 5 will determine final placement and the end of the competition the final rankings of all players will be posted. Top male and female players win bragging rights and accusations of shuttle tampering.

For registered platers the cost is \$50.00 for the 5 weeks (\$75 for unregistered players), payable on the first night with players supplying their own shuttles. Anticipated shuttle usage is approximately 2 per player per night and shuttles will be available for purchase on the night. As with normal rosters if you are unable to play you will need to organise a replacement player, preferably of a similar grade.

## Badminton Devil Tournament

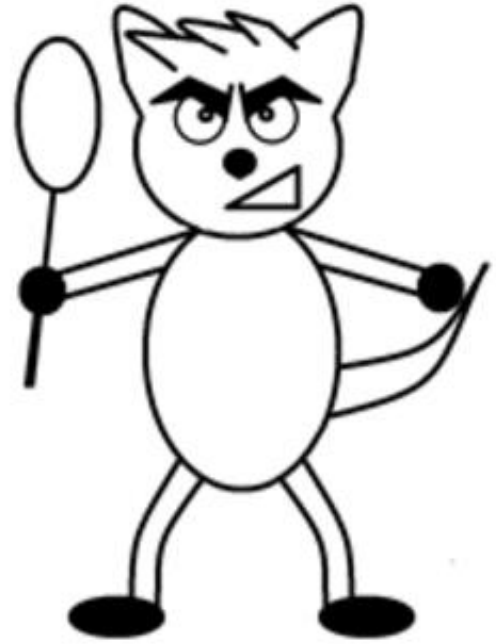
