- 1.The tournament will be conducted by the Southern Tasmanian Badminton Association’s (STBA) Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Program (CALD) with all events open to members registered with any affiliated body of the BWF.
- 2.Players from ALL nationalities and backgrounds are welcome to join, however you must be staying/studying/working in Australia to participate in this tournament.
- 3.All matches will be played under the rules of Badminton adopted by the BWF.
- 4.Each competitor **must submit an entry form and forward with relevant entry fee – failure to do so will deem you ineligible to compete** – to Program Manager Ernest Ng (as per address in the front of this form). - 5.Each player will be allowed to play in the ONE grade only and up to THREE events in that grade.
- 6.All entry forms are to be submitted to Ernest Ng CALD Program Manager by 5:00pm on 15 March 2013.
- 7.**Late entries will not be accepted.**
- 8.Entries will be accepted in accordance with the current State / Territory grading list. The tournament referee has reserved the right to regrade any player according to Badminton Australia’s (BA) National Ranking Database.
- 9.Matches in all grades will be scored under the current BWF scoring system best of 3 games to 21.
- 10.Players must be ready to play when called upon, absent players will forfeit the game.
- 11.Acceptable badminton sports clothing must be worn.
- 12.Players are requested to wear street shoes only to the hall.
- 13.The first named player(s) in opening matches of a session shall provide the umpire for that match. Thereafter and whenever practical, the losing side shall umpire the next match on that court.
