PRODUCT REVIEW

Gosen G Tone 9 & Momone String

The new range of strings from Gosen arrived at the beginning of 2016. After some trials there are two stand-out string options in this range; G Tone 9 and Momone. G Tone 9 provides excellent durability due to being a relatively thick string at (0.69 mm). This string also provides good power with a sharp (hard) feel. G Tone 9 has become the preferred choice for many players playing multiple times a week including the weekend tournaments. Momone is also proving to be a very reliable string option for those wanting a thinner string (0.66 mm) providing maximum power. The soft feel of the Momone makes it one of the most comfortable of the thinner strings available. However, Momone has limited durability and is suited for players wanting a good string for a short period, such as through a tournament. To have your racquet strung with either of these strings will cost \$27 a little cheaper than other specialist Strings.
